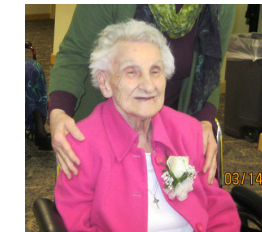
Mini-Minutes of the Pastoral Council
