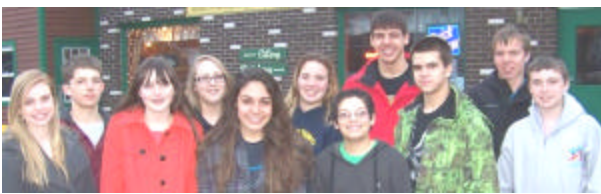

### Pastoral Council Meeting info:

- Shared info:
  - This week there is a Warren Country Parish Planning meeting to point us toward the future.
  - The digging of the drainage ditch will begin after 4/21
  - The conclusion of the deposition regarding the lawsuit will be in May
- Finance Council discussed Bishop's Appeal, School Assessment, committee budgets, and the need for new fundraising ideas. July 24th is the "Community Appreciation Day" at GFN Bank when St. C's can raise funds through raffles etc.
- "Teach Committee" raised the question of how best to "deliver" faith formation to our children when scheduling for families is so difficult. The committee is looking into re-vamping the program to assist families. Lack of "person power" is the reason for not planning a Vacation Bible School. Noted was the coming VBS at the Free Methodist Church and "Kids Klub" at the Episcopal Church run by Youthworks.
- "Gather Committee" will plan the reception following First Communion, is planning a float for the bicentennial parade July 4th, and will assist with the Parish Picnic on June 2.
- "Worship Committee" plans to post Mass Times etc in the local campgrounds. The Children's Chapel is slowly being "renovated." The Triduum was given rave reviews.
- "Serve Committee" discussed how to involve parishioners in care for the Church. The idea of a ministry fair keeps coming to mind. Ministers of Care are hosting a dinner at the end of the month for a "Group of Interesting Parishioners". A way for folks to get to know each other. Invitations have been sent.

Finally all "missionaries" are back in town and our "Gang from Guatemala" will plan the presentation for the parish and future ministry here and abroad. Watch for details! If you are interested in going to Guatemala next year, please let Sister Linda know and start saving about \$1,000. A small group works best.

### A few money notes:

**Why use Envelopes** The envelopes we currently use are "one size fits all." Whenever there is a special collection, or you want to give something for the kids' mission trip or there is a fire in town and you want to help that person or want to give to the North Country Emergency Fund, you can write one check. Without lots of announcements about money, you can simply look at your envelope to see where money is needed. You can determine where your money goes. If you don't use envelopes now but would like to start, mention it to Sister Linda asap. Thanks.

This little church gave over \$6,000 in **Alms** this past Lent! This is astounding... And shows tremendous faith and trust. Astounding.

**Bishop's Appeal** is around the corner. Our responsibility is this year is \$21,366. About 180 families have carried our parish as we paid the assessment in the past. 120 families do financially support St. C's. To make it fair, once again we request that those 120 households make a decent contribution toward a second bill we have for which there is no special collection: **Catholic School Assessment**, approximately \$10,000. If those 120 households do not help, this \$10,000 is taken out of our weekend collection (as is any deficit for the Bishop's Appeal.). Translated into reality, five or six weekends worth of church support would go NOT to keep St. C's floating, but to Catholic Schools..... To not give to the Bishop's Appeal and/or not give to the School Assessment is to hurt St. C's..
