 by Joan Chittister

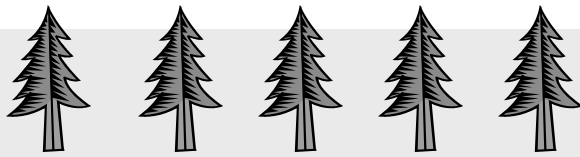
