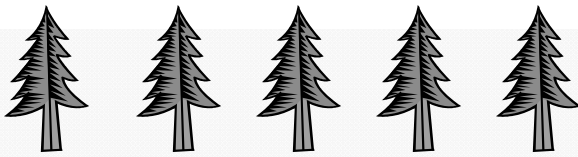
Michael Lerner, editor, Tikken Magazine, states: "The Gift of
