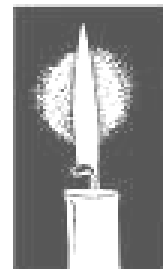

Last weekend, the community offered \$2861.25 to support the mission and ministry Christ through Saint Cecilia's. For the emergency fund of North Country Ministry, \$281.70 was offered. Our "Boot Bench" netted \$500, thanks to the generosity of Dick Ouellete. (The second bench is just about ready!.. The hold up is slh.) At Sister Anne Bryan Smollin's wonderful presentation on Thursday evening, the attendees gifted the church with \$500 toward the building fund.

Just fyi, the sooner we pay off our debt, the less it will cost us. We now owe the diocese \$20,161.15 for the hall renovation and \$110,523.45 for the renovation of the church. The interest is 5.5%. Out-right donations are always welcome!
