*Do you need a car seat? Car seats are available from the NCM Baby's Place Program. To qualify for a car seat, you must be receiving one of the following forms of public assistance: **Medicaid *WIC *SSI *Food Stamps verification of need by the Department of Social services.** All recipients of car seats will receive approx. 2 hours of classroom and hands-on instruction on the proper use of car seats. 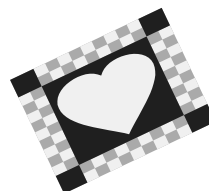

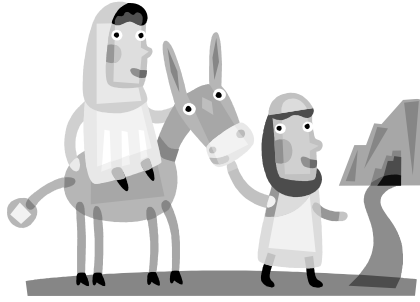
