As North Country Ministry moves into its 20th year, there are a few changes ahead. What started out as "leaven" in the beginning has grown into a major outreach ministry in our North Country. What began as three small Catholic Parishes (St. James', Sacred Heart, St. C's) and the Sisters of Mercy, Sisters of St. Joseph, and Sisters of the Sacred Heart supporting the ministry, the work has grown as the needs increased. NCM is now an ecumenical effort with a board of professional people, major fundraising, and a web page!. Many more faith communities are involved than in the beginning. What began as an effort of the Catholic Community has now grown into an Ecumenical effort. After 19 years of hosting the bi-weekly "Gathering Place," a hot lunch for everyone who arrives, St. Cecilia's is sharing the opportunity to serve. Beginning this Fall, the Gathering Place will be hosted by the Presbyterian Church on Stewart Farrar Street. The Gathering Place will no longer be held at St. Cecilia's Jaracz Hall. 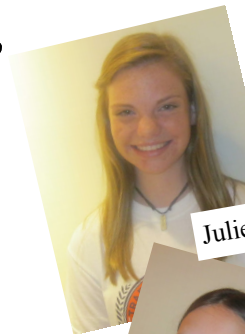

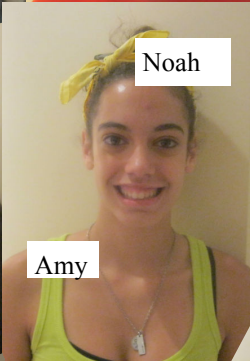
