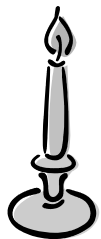

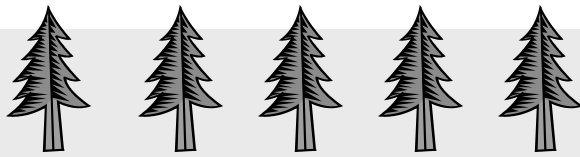

Financial Stewardship

\$3048 toward the maintenance and ministry costs at St. C's. \$344 of the offering was "make-up". (Thanks!) All totaled, \$1073.12 was profit on the four breakfasts. The money goes toward our debt to the diocese.. \$297 was donated last weekend to be included in our Pope's emergency fund. This is called "Peter's Pence". Thank You! The community offered \$262 for Vacation Bible School scholarships. A "friend of St. C's" outright gave us \$400 to do with what we want. Since it was a tithe in the first place, we also "tithed" and put \$40 into the fund for the poor and \$360 in the Building Fund. Many parishioners and summerites use the yellow envelopes to help with the debt. This past week, an additional \$215 was given outright by parishioners and \$50 given by "Summerites." \$176 was offered for our fuel bill and another parishioner offered \$50 for liturgical needs. Thank you, one and all.
