is where Sister Linda went in November to visit Mary Beth Gallagher who works
with Maryknoll for Catholic AIDS Action in that country. Mary Beth is the daugh-
ter of Sue and John who own a second home on Trout Lake and who are faithful
"Seasonalites" of St. C's. In fact, for one term, John was on the Pastoral Council
and would drive six hours round trip to get to our meetings!! Mary Beth coordi-
nates an after school program, an all day Saturday soccer league, and a bi-
monthly day at the pool!! (In between, she is tutoring, planning lessons, coordi-
nating volunteers, shopping for school supplies, encouraging her kids, helping
other missionaries, making connections via Rotary Club, taking the kids to lead-
ership camps, etc! MB is a busy gal!!)

ANYWAY....

When Mary Beth brings her 300 best friends to the city pool, (she gets them in
free!!!) the children cannot swim unless they have swimsuits. (Most of these
kids don't have shoes! Why would they have a swim suit?) So, that is why
we are collecting good used swimsuits for skinny grammar school kids!
When Mary Beth comes to us the weekend of March 21, we can present
them to her!!! Spread the word. Let's get as many suits as possible!

MEANWHILE....

Let's go with Mary Beth's kids as the recipient of our Lenten Rice Bowl Alms.
We will aim at purchasing school supplies, school shoes and uniforms, school
