Note: A PATEN is a small plate, usually made of silver or gold, used to hold the Eucharistic Bread which is to be consecrated. It is used by the Eucharistic Ministers during distribution of Communion. The reserved hosts are stored in the TABERNACLE in a CIBORIUM.
