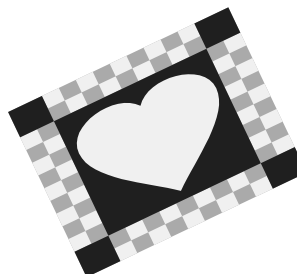

Guides for our personal prayer....

First Reading

Book of the prophet Ezekiel, Chapter 2, Verses 2-5

1. Are there prophets in your life? Are you sometimes stubborn and closed about listening to their message? Why? Why do you reject the person or the message?
2. Do you think the ordinary prophet has great success or runs into opposition most of the time? Have you and/or your ideas ever been rejected when you tried to change something for the better? How do you handle rejection?

Second Reading

Second Letter to the Corinthians, Chapter 12, Verses 7-10

1. If you went out shopping for weaknesses or crosses to bear, would you pick the ones you already have or would you pick different ones? Why? Do you find God in your weakness? Can it be a constant source of grace?
2. "My grace is sufficient for you," Christ said. Do you or your friends rely on these words? Are they easy to remember or hard?

Gospel

According to Mark, Chapter 6, Verses 1-6

2. Which hurts worse, rejection by strangers or by friends? Call to mind the times Jesus felt rejection. Can you think of theologians, saints, or scientists who were rejected for their ideas?
2. How is your rejection related to Jesus'? When you are denounced, what good thing happens to you? Whose power are you using when you have none of your own?
