Bishop Thomas Mar Eusebius and his priests represent the Syro-Malankara Catholic Apostolic Exarchate A community of Syro-Malankara Catholics emigrated from India to New York in 1984. Their community continues to thrive and grow. The Church is an Eastern Catholic Church based in the southwest Indian state of Kerala. It has more than 400,000 members including 10,000 in

North America. It is one of the two Eastern church that, along with the Latin Church, make up the Catholic Church in India. The other is the Syro-Malabar Catholic Church. An apostolic exarchate in the Eastern Catholic Church is the equivalent of an apostolic vicariate in the Latin Church and is created by the Vatican for the pastoral care of Catholics living outside the territory of the Eastern church to which they belong. In the US there are 16 Syro-Malankara parishes and 15 churches. There are 30 priests and 34 women religious who minister to these churches. Bishop Thomas Mar Eusebius is responsible for churches in USA, Canada, and Europe. Rev. Abraham Lukose is the bishop's secretary and Rev. Sunny Matthew is vicar at St. Peter's Rockland in New York. **WELCOME!!!**
