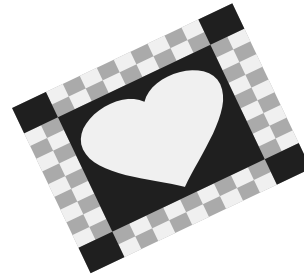

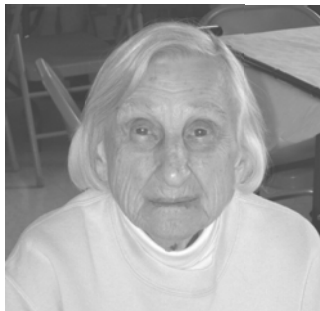

To qualify for a car seat, you must be receiving one of the following forms of public assistance: * **Medicaid** * **WIC** * **SSI** * **Food Stamps** **Verification of need by the Department of Social services.** All recipients of car seats will receive approx. 2 hours of classroom and hands-on instruction on the proper use of car seats.
