**So Here Is the Scoop!!!!**

This week, Sister Linda and Gail DeMarsh will be attending a program at Maryknoll about Adult Faith Formation in the 21st Century. They will return on Friday evening. Starting on the 18th, Gail DeMarsh will officially be a part time staff member of St. Cecilia's Parish as Pastoral Assistant for Administration. A complete list of Gail's responsibilities is hanging on the bulletin board, for all interested. In a nutshell, Gail will learn and take care of much of the day to day business of the parish as well as assist with pastoral duties as needed. Her responsibilities revolve primarily around liturgy and the details of the office. Dawn Brunner is beginning her 14th year as St. C's bookkeeper and person in charge of the cemetery. Dawn has kept us floating and has done a great job whittling away at our debt. Between Dawn and Gail, the parish is in good hands! On a volunteer basis, Gail will continue to be able to direct the Rites of Christian Initiation of Adults and be on the golf committee.



So, who will replace Phyllis as director of Faith Formation, K-youth????? No one! Phyllis cannot be replaced for many reasons. One is that Phyllis gave her time and resources way beyond anything the parish could afford! We could not pay a qualified person a just wage to do all that Phyllis did. Phyllis went "way beyond the call of duty!" So, Gail will do the administration connected with Faith Formation (and there is quite a bit!) and Sister Linda with the faith formation instructors and parents will figure out the rest (they hope!).

The decision to hire Gail went through the finance council, the pastoral council, and the Diocesan Office of Human Resources. Sister Linda is quite happy about Gail's desire to serve the parish because she has worked with Gail for years on a volunteer basis, knows Gail is quite qualified, and knows that Gail wants to serve for all the right reasons. Welcome, Gail!! (Officially, that is!)
