#### FYI from NCM

A little over two years ago, North Country Ministry  
(NCM) opened its Outreach Center in Warrensburg.  
Unintentionally, it matched the beginnings of the eco-  
nomic downturn. Over 800 people walked through the  
Center's doors in the first month and the numbers have  
remained high. Rising prices for heat, electric and the  
growing demand for financial assistance have chal-  
lenged NCM's funding sources. The Governing Board  
of NCM is working at increasing its funding sources to  
meet this challenge. One step will be to introduce  
charges for clothing. Starting August 1 there will be \$1  
a bag charge. This minimal charge will help toward the  
expense of operating this Center. We will, of course,  
provide these services without cost to those in greatest  
need.
