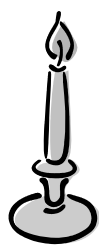

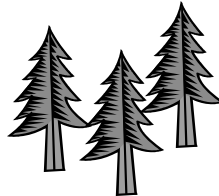

Last weekend, the Community offered \$1959 toward
the maintenance costs and salaries at St. C's \$36 of the
offering was "make-up". \$89.65 worth of returnables
was donated to support the youth trip; \$15 was do-
nated toward the cost of liturgical needs; \$296 was
given via the "bell jar" toward gas for the mission trip
and another \$45 via the collection; \$110 was donated
toward the building fund. (We are only \$52,026.40 in
debt!!)

This past week, Ed Gaiotti, Joe Barlow, and Sister
Linda attended a meeting with our diocesan lawyer,
chief financial office, real property administrator, and
an engineer and architect that the diocese consults.
The task was to determine the next step in the leak-
ing roof and watery basement problem-solving proc-
ess. After much discussion (actually two and a half
years worth!), it was agreed that we need to avoid
having the snow remain on the narthex roof and
backing up under the slate.... and.... avoid having
the snow pile up against the building all winter. Solu-
tions were discussed and will be drawn up by the
architect and engineer within the next two months.
A cost will be attached. If our original architect is
willing to agree, his insurance will pay for the correc-
tive measures and the work will proceed. If the solu-
tion is challenged, then we move to another level.
This synopsis is simply keeping informed those in the
community who are interested.
