## For Sale: Juan Ana Coffee— a deal even more just than Fair Trade!!!

The Juan Ana Coffee program began twenty years ago at San Lucas Mission by asking small farmers what was needed for their best quality coffee. Their answer was \$26 for 100 pounds of unprocessed cerezo coffee. This is roughly triple the price that they would receive through Fair Trade standards, which provides between 10-12% above market prices. Maximizing local benefits of the product, all washing, sorting, grading, packing, weighing, and even sewing of the coffee bags is done by hand in the San Lucas Mission. (We helped!!)

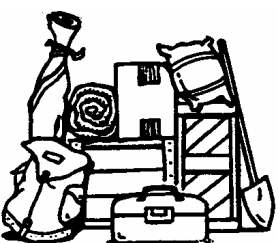

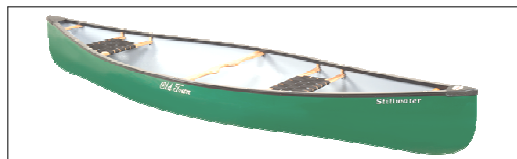

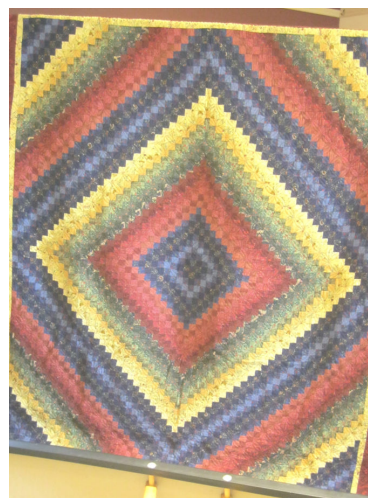
