### A Plea from the Russo Family....

*Our grand nephew, Matthew Robert Blake, is a 3 year old boy, from Queensbury.. He was happy and healthy until 7 weeks ago when he developed flu like symptoms and could not walk. After visiting Glens Falls Hospital, he was sent to Albany Medical Center for testing. The MRI discovered he had MEDULLABLASTOMA, a severe form of brain cancer. The doctors removed the tumor at Albany Medical Center on March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2011. After his surgery, he started having seizures and had to be medevaced to St. Jude's Children's Hospital in Memphis, Tennessee.*

*Upon his arrival, he was put in a medically induced coma. He was in the intensive care unit with pressure on his brain and blood clots. He has cancer cells floating around his brain and down his spinal cord. At the present time he is receiving strong radiation treatment, Monday thru Friday for 6 weeks and then he will have 4 months of chemotherapy. Matthew's cancer will require long term care.*
