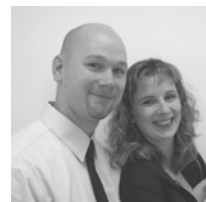

In honor of the years of service given by Sister Catherine and Sister Mary (total 135!!), a gift in their name was given by St. C's to support the ministry of NCM in Warrensburg.

The new Center will house offices for NCM's Caseworker and Family Support Worker. It will also be the new home of the Family Clothing Center and the Baby's Place.

NCM's staff will be there to offer a "Hand of Hope" through supportive listening, referrals, advocacy and direct assistance when possible.

The Family Clothing Center is open to anyone in the community. The Baby's Place will offer gently used and new infant and toddler clothing (newborn to 4T), baby furniture, and other items. An infant car seat program will also be offered. The on-going support of the Warrensburg Center will rely on the continuing support of the local churches, the community and the donations of those who use the programs.
