### BISHOP'S APPEAL 2011

The Diocesan Budget for 2011-2012 is set. Needed from  
St. Cecilia's is \$21,588 WE CAN DO IT!

So far, we have \$10,933 pledged, \$1648 paid, with a balance  
of \$9285 on the pledges. Hopefully, those who have yet to  
pledge will offer \$10,655.

**And then there is always the  
School Assessment!**

2010/2011..... \$9,871 We still owe \$7,000  
2011/2012... ..\$9,387 For "next" year.  
Last weekend, \$180 was pledged and \$60 was paid. TY!!!

After our plea to help with the two assessments (Diocesan and  
School), the balance of the money not paid money comes out of  
our Weekend Collection for Church Support.

### In Effect....

For 2011/2012, St. C's owes the Diocese  
\$30,975.

(Plus the \$7,000 for the 1010-2011 we still owe for the Schools)
