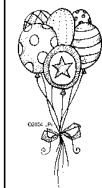

BISHOP'S APPEAL 2011

The Diocesan Budget for 2011-2012 is set. Needed from
St. Cecilia's is \$21,588 WE CAN DO IT!
So far, 66 households have pledged \$15,943.

And then there is always the School Assessment!

2010/2011..... \$9,871 We still owe \$7,000
2011/2012... ..\$9,387 For "next" year.
As of last weekend, \$335 have been promised.

After our plea to help with the two assessments (Diocesan and
School), the balance of the money not paid money comes out of
our Weekend Collection for Church Support.

In Effect....

For 2011/2012, St. C's owes the Diocese
\$30,975 .
(Plus the \$7,000 for the 1010-2011 we still owe for the Schools)

"Just to be clear...."

What we do not collect via this appeal,
comes out of our operating monies.

This bill belongs to the entire parish.

Every single household is asked to
contribute SOMETHING. Even \$1 a month is a huge help.

Treasure Stewardship

- \$2106 was offered last weekend o support St. C's ministry and maintenance. .
 - \$90 was given as a donation
 - \$125 was donated toward the Mission Trip
 - \$344 was donated as "make up"
 - \$20 was given for Catholic Relief Services
 - \$65 was donated toward the Building Fund
- (So many generous people!)

The Balance We Owe on our Building Renovation is
now

\$17,315.66..... Totally Amazing!

who have continued to give their monthly Building Fund pledge

Parishioners at St. C's
both love the Church and are incredibly generous.)
