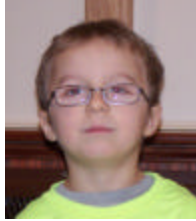

Update on Lawsuits and Ditches!

Soon corrective measures will be taken to reme-
 dy the problem of water running along the south side
 of the Church (between church and sidewalk), through
 the original foundation, and into the basement. Beside
 the fact that the foundation is being compromised,
 there is also a new mold problem.

Thank you to all who prayed for Sister Linda
 on Friday as she completed her deposition (part one
 was November, 2011!!!) regarding the "roof issue" on
 the new addition to the Church. Actually, the "roof
 issue" resulted in the drainage issue. The problem pre-
 sented itself in March 2008. Hopefully, the lawsuit and
 corrective measures will be completed in our lifetime.
