A Note to the folks who have not yet pledged or contributed to the BISHOP'S APPEAL

- \$20,758 is a "bill/assessment" that belongs to the entire community. Less than half the church pays it, however. Somehow, that is not fair.
- Money is very tight. If that is why you are not giving, then please, give \$1 out of good will and as a way to participate in this responsibility. Don't be embarrassed. It is the GIVING that is important more than the amount. There is no judgment about amounts. Please participate.
- "NO! I am NOT giving to the APPEAL because..."

If in your mind you have a really good reason to not support the Bishop's Appeal, then please consider this—again, as a matter of fairness. There is another assessment St. C's must pay. We do not hold a special collection for it. We owe \$9,871 to the diocese for the Catholic School Assessment. So far, 5 households have contributed toward this bill. Please join them. What you ordinarily would or could give to the Bishop's Appeal, give instead toward the payment of the School Bill. Be sure to mark your contribution clearly: SCHOOL.

The parish has 2 assessments totaling \$30,629.

To date, 85 households have contributed to one or the other or both assessments. The parish has close to 300 households. Thanks for considering this.
