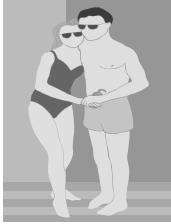

Thank you to all who were able to contribute to support the ministry and maintenance at Saint Cecilia's last weekend. The support totaled \$2464.47 (We are getting there! At this rate, we only need 55 weekends in a year to make our budget! Terrific!) On Ascension Thursday, the collection was \$126 (\$51 is the parish portion) and \$127 was donated to assist the struggling churches of Eastern Europe.

For our Bishop's Appeal, 111 households have contributed so far, 1/3 of the community. Thanks! The total pledged and given to date is \$21,675 .

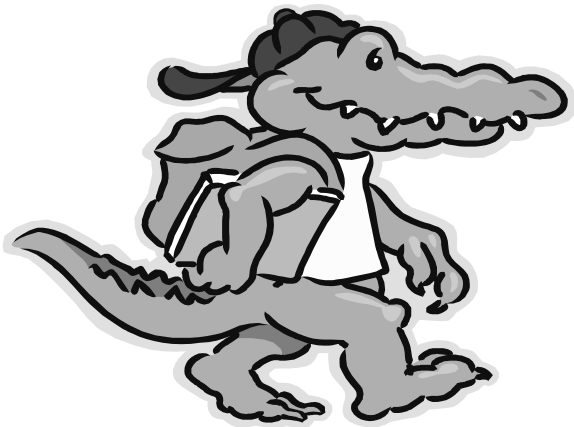

(Note: Grades 7 and up are welcome! Five hours for the parish goes quickly when you volunteer at a breakfast.)

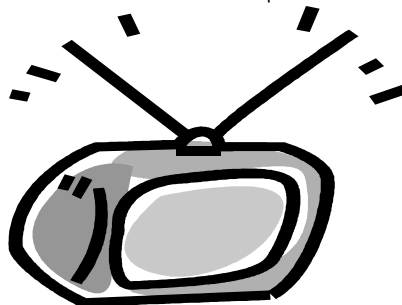
For the folks unable to financially support the parish, offering a bit of time to help with fundraising is a great alternative. We really need you!
