The Diocesan Budget for 2011-2012 is set. Needed from St. Cecilia's \$21,588

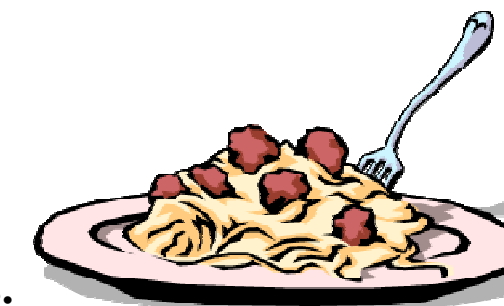
