The Roman Missal, the source of our prayers, is now in its third edition since 1974. It is marked by a shift from the style of language of the first two editions, which was immediately accessible and easy to understand. The prayers themselves, though, were not always accurate translations of the original Latin texts. *The Roman Missal, The Third Edition*, on the other hand, makes use of a more formal style of English. The prayers are intended to be more literal renderings of the original Latin text so that the meaning contained in them is accurately expressed in English. Listening to and praying the prayers of the Mass, essential ingredients of active participation in the liturgy, will require some work. Some background on the nature of the prayers, the principles of translation, and the purpose of liturgical prayer will help all of us to take up this work. (Rev.
