First Sunday of Advent

There are two noticeable changes in the words of consecration in the new Roman Missal. Introducing the words of Christ, said over the wine, the priest will say, "...when supper was ended, he took the chalice..." Choosing the word chalice instead of cup emphasizes that this vessel is no ordinary cup. Indeed, it highlights the sacrificial character of this vessel which holds the Precious Blood of Jesus Christ, shed for us out of love.

The next difference is in the words of Christ at the consecration of the wine as the priest says, "Take this all of you and drink from it, for this is the chalice of my blood...which will be poured out for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins." The change of "for all" to "for many" maintains the words of Christ as recorded in the Gospels of Matthew (26:28) and Mark (14:24), thus making the Scriptural allusion more obvious. At the same time, it does not change our Catholic understanding that Christ is the Savior of the whole world and that his sacrifice was made
