The TEACH COUNCIL (Present: Leigh Cain, Sue Shepler) are planning interesting and fun ways to boost the attendance for the K-11 gatherings and ways for the children to have liturgical roles at Eucharist. The FINANCE COUNCIL (Present: Harriet Bunker, Linda Gaiotti, Lorry O'Connor) discussed the boiler issues, where to get the best interest on a loan, and whether or not we ought to sell West Wing.
