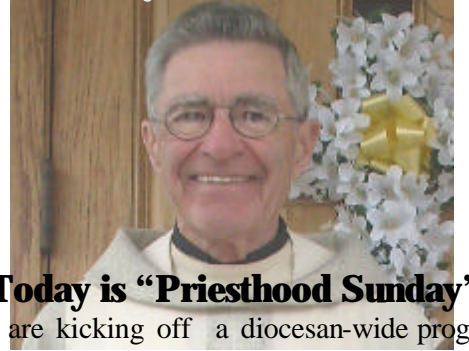

Today is "Priesthood Sunday"

And we are kicking off a diocesan-wide program entitled, "Called by Name." The goal of the program is to identify single men (ages 16-55) in our parish who have the spiritual and leadership gifts to possibly be a priest someday. The weekends of November 17/18 and 24/25 are the key weekends in this effort. Over the next month, please prayerfully consider what men from our parish might be someone whose name you could submit on the weekend of November 24/25. The enclosed brochure contains a description of the program, the qualities desired in a candidate for the priesthood, and a wonderful vocation prayer.

(Note: We currently have 90 active diocesan priests serving 128 parishes. In 8 years, 2020, it is projected that we will have 39 active priests.)

R. This is the diocesan formation for ministry program that is being attended by 3 parishioners. They are doing this entirely for the purpose of serving this community. We can show our gratitude by helping with their tuition cost. It totals \$600/year each.

BOILER BUSINESS, fy!

At this writing, the boiler in the church is just about ready to be fired up. The total cost is \$6800. 8 parish households, 2 "seasonal households," and 1 visiting household have contributed to the cost. We are still "short." Unfortunately, the convent boiler's future is still to be determined. If it can be repaired, it will cost about \$800. We will know this week if it can be "saved" or needs to be replaced. (big bucks) (None of this was budgeted. All donations welcome. Thanks!)
