

This fall, St. James' Episcopal Church is sponsoring a Discussion Course on Voluntary Simplicity based on material published by the Northwest Earth Institute, Portland, Oregon. The course is open to all. We will address the distractions of modern society that keep us from caring for ourselves, our relationships and our environment. Subjects will include "The Meaning of Simplicity", "Living More with Less" and "Putting it into Practice". The group will meet six consecutive Tuesdays from 4:30 PM to 6:00 PM in the Parish Hall at 172 Ottawa Street. The first session will be October 14, the last November 20 (one week before Thanksgiving). The cost of the material is \$19. While there will be a coordinator for the sessions, there will be no "teacher". The focus will be on personal reactions to the readings and on personal values, opinions, feelings and experiences. The course is not for problem-solving, and consensus is not a goal. You may sign up for the course by calling the Church office at 518-668-2001.

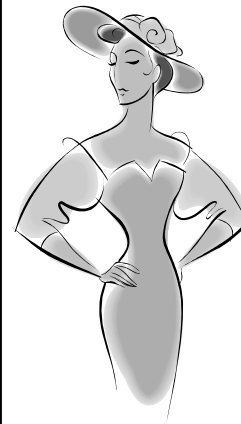

## FINANCE COUNCIL

*The Parish Finance Council met last Thursday to review our current situation. In short, all our bills are current and our debt is being reduced.*

*At this moment, we owe the diocese  
\$13,323.47 on the Hall Renovation  
and  
\$100,515.99 on the Church.*

*We expect \$35,362 to be paid on pledges this coming year. It is hoped that parishioners who were not able to assist with the debt in the past will do so when their circumstances change. A number of parishioners verbally have promised monies toward the hall renovation, but seem to have forgotten. SLH is too shy to remind them.*

*Fundraising efforts will continue. A Fashion Show will be held next Sunday at the Lodge on Echo Lake. The Faith Formation Families will sponsor the Christmas in Warrensburg at St. C's. These same folks will sponsor a yet-to-be-decided fundraising event on May 31. It is hoped that more parishioners will offer their time next Summer. There will be a Corned Beef Dinner March 14 and probably a breakfast or two during the winter. Because this is the year of the 75th jubilee of Sister Catherine and 50th jubilee of Sister Mary, a reception for them will be held January 24th, 5:30 to 7PM.*

*As of October 9, St. C's has \$18,000 in the Building Fund Checking Account, \$20,415 in the Church Checking Account, and \$23,000 in savings.*

*It was agreed that we need to continue to support Adult Education and Ministry Formation. Currently, Irene Harrison is in her first year of the Diocesan Formation for Ministry. Gail DeMarsh is being certified as Liturgical Coordinator and RCIA director. Pam Heyer is involved in the "Ministers of Care" training. We need to think of the future and be ready for a "leadership change" for the day when it happens.*

*No decision has been made on the roof repair yet. We are leaning toward metal. Because it won't be repaired before our snows, it will be necessary to rake the roof this winter.*

*Serious consideration is being given to finding a less costly distributor for our fuel oil, purchasing Fair Trade Coffee, and tithing our income/fundraising. Expressing gratitude to the many folks who are consistently generous with their time, talents, and treasure was agreed by all.*

- ◆ To save heat, the hall will be used for Faith Formation Super Sundays and Special Events. No class will be held in the hall. Three classes will be held in the convent. This will be evaluated as time marches on.
- ◆ The roof situation is now in the hands of a lawyer. The expected remedy is some sort of metal roof over most of the addition. It is advised that the interior damage not be repaired until the roof is.
- ◆ The Fashion Show is next Sunday with great hopes for a wonderful and successful event. Mucho Gracias to Richelene Morey and her committee!
- ◆ There is a request for a women's group at St. C's and the Divine Mercy Devotion.
- ◆ Ministers of Care have limited their goals to our sick and homebound. Brenda Beadnell and Judy Rozell received orientation at the hospital and will visit St. C parishioners there. Currently, Pam Heyer is taking the Minister of Care Certification Course to visit the sick. Judy Rozell is networking with "NY Connects" to keep abreast of all services available. At the next meeting, we will discuss the need for organization of our Service Ministry. (TY Judy!)
- ◆ Youth Ministry is now a cooperative effort in our Cluster. World Youth Mass will be at St. C's 10/26, Confirmation Retreat is next Sunday, etc. Service Ministries are developing among our youth and families: Tom and Travis Birkholz will moderate our fifth and sixth grade boys in four projects; there is a father / sons group forming to give service; "Make a Difference Day" already has a number of families signed up; our young ladies are creating a service organization for which they will officially receive "Catholic Recognition for Service." (Watch for details! TY Phyllis!)
- ◆ Deborah Stephenson and Irene Harrison will be our reps on the Called to Be Church cluster oversight committee.
- ◆ Concern: Sister Linda and Phyllis Welsh are not getting younger. How can we develop leadership in the community to insure our future? Education and Ministry Formation are critical.
