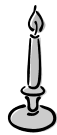

Because there is a slight chance that an entrance to the office could be made at the back of the convent. When the town was approached about this, they said, "Never over a fuel tank!" So, removing the tank is just trying to think ahead, just in case. It would be a lot harder to remove at a future date if it was full of cement! The third reason is that Mark Miller knows all about fuel tank removal and is guiding the process so it is done "right.")
