### Time /Talent Stewardship

So, removing the tank is just trying to think ahead, just in case there is ever a real parish office and a real office entrance. It would be a lot harder to remove a fuel tank at a future date if it was full of cement! The third reason is that Mark Miller knows all about fuel tank removal (it's his business!) and is guiding the process so it is done "right.")
