### Stephen Foster's Music Topic of Bicentennial Talk

The music of Stephen Foster is the topic of a talk by William Maher on Thursday evening, September 19, at 7 PM, at St. Cecilia's Church. Sponsored by the Warrensburgh Historical Society, the talk is part of Warrensburg's year-long Bicentennial Celebration. Although he only lived 38 years, Stephen Foster was known as the "father of American music," primarily for his parlour and minstrel music. Foster wrote over 200 songs; among his best known are Oh! Susanna, Camp-town Races, Old Folks at Home, Jeanie with the Light Brown Hair, and Beautiful Dreamer. Many of his compositions remain popular, more than 150 years after he wrote them. Bill Maher and his wife retired to Warrensburg in 1999 from Brooklyn, New York. Bill has long been a student of operatic and other music and continues to conduct a monthly Opera Club session at his home here, as he did in Brooklyn. He will play a sampling of Foster's music and discuss his life and times. **THIS THURSDAY....COME!**

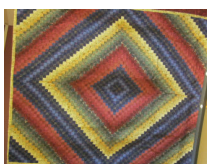

On September 21 a variety of groups, organizations and people worldwide will host and attend *International Day of Peace*. In 2002, the U.N. General Assembly officially declared September 21 as the permanent date for the International Day of Peace. Anyone, anywhere can celebrate Peace Day. It can be as simple as lighting a candle at noon, or just sitting in silent meditation. Or, it can involve getting your co-workers, organization, community or government engaged in a large event. If millions of people in all parts of the world come together for one day of peace, the impact will be immense. **International Day of Peace is also a Day of Ceasefire** – personal or political. *Take this opportunity to make peace in your own relationships as to impact the larger conflicts of our time. Imagine what a whole Day of Ceasefire would mean to humankind!*

**HAVE YOU LOST TELEVISED MASS?** In late July, Time Warner Cable began broadcasting public access television channels in digital format only. As a result, customers who own older, analog TVs and **do not have cable boxes** need a digital adapter in order to watch these channels. This includes the channels on which "Table of the Lord" televised Mass is aired. If you know someone who is missing televised Mass, please call Time Warner at 1-855-286-1736 to order a digital adapter, or go to www.twc.com/digitaladapter. The adapters come with instructions, or call Time Warner at the same number if assistance is needed. **Adapters ordered before September 23** will avoid a 99 cent monthly service charge through 2014. Starting January 1, 2015, the 99 cent monthly fee will go into effect for everyone, regardless of when the adapter is ordered (unless returned by then).
