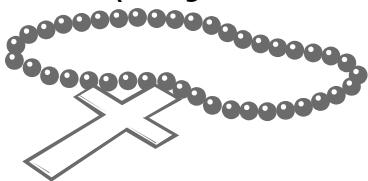

WHO IS INVOLVED WITH THE RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS?

We all are – it is a process for the whole faith community!

Inquirer – Catechumen/Candidates – Elect – Neophyte Who are these people? They are all one and the same. The names reflect where the person is on their faith journey in the process known as **The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)**.

The Isaac Jogues Cluster (Sacred Heart, Blessed Sacrament and St. C's) has a core RCIA team with a small cadre of volunteers to assist in this faith journey process. Clustering offers all three faith communities the opportunity to share in the process. This includes the ability to provide the rites at a given parish in the cluster so the parishes within the cluster get to meet the catechumen(s) and candidate(s). It also allows the parishes to experience the rites should they not have anyone from their parish in the process. The catechumen(s) and candidate(s) experience that the church is not just one parish community but the community of faithful in the cluster. You are part of that process and can become more involved as part of your baptismal call.

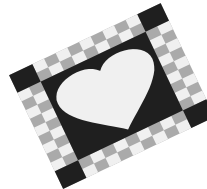
Alaska Anyone?
