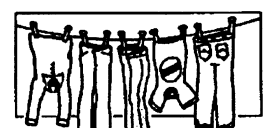

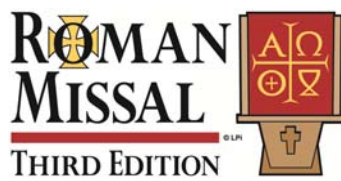

How are we preparing for the change at St. C's?

For one thing, we are slowly learning the Mass of Christ the Savior by Dan Schutte. This Mass was written with the "new wording" that will be used as of November 27. Those parts of the Mass that have no word change will be sung asap.... as we learn it. We started last weekend to sing the AMEN and this weekend we will add the ALLELUIA. To learn it, just listen to the music ministers practicing before Eucharist begins. They are singing the new Mass parts as preludes from now on.

RCIA (Rites of Christian Initiation of Adults) is in full swing. If you or someone you know is interested in knowing more about the Church or is interested in joining, then now is the time and this is the place! **Inquirers...** are the folks just asking questions.
