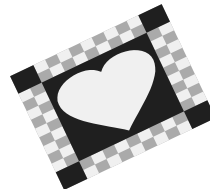

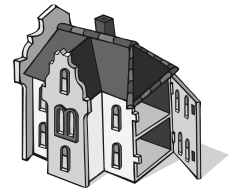

A School for the Service of the Lord - Monasticism

A three-part introduction to **monastic history, life, practice, and spirituality**;

This program will provide participants with a broad overview of the development of monastic life in the western church, a description of the diverse types of monasticism with an emphasis on American foundations, and a discussion of monastic practices and spirituality.

A major emphasis of this program is the application of monastic principles to daily life in the secular world. The program will be conducted over three weeks with each presentation offered in three locations each week. **Participants may choose to attend any site.**

Each week's presentation is designed to stand alone so that participants may attend as many or as few as their interest and schedule permits.

Session 1: History – The Middle East to America

Session 2: The Rule and the diversity of monastic communities

Session 3: Spirituality and Life

This program has been approved for Catechist / Youth Ministry credit.

Each Session is awarded 2 hour course credits as follows:

Session 1 – History – Advanced Certification – Theology/Scripture: Ecclesiology. (2 credits)
 Session 2 – The Rule & Diversity of Communities – Elective for Enrichment & Renewal. (2 credits)
 Session 3 – Spirituality & Life – Advanced Certification – Spiritual Renewal. (2 credits)
