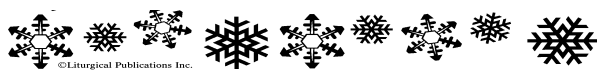


Good News for Sunday Skiers-

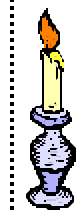
