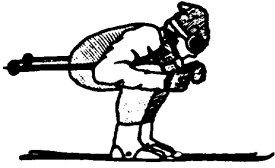

Yeah! No need to miss skiing!!!!



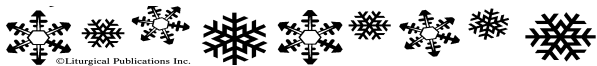
