



Saint Kateri Tekakwitha

The daughter of an Algonquin mother and a Mohawk chief was born in 1656 in what is today, Fonda New York. When she was four years old, her parents and brother died of smallpox. Kateri survived, but the disease left her scarred and her sight impaired. She was named "Tekakwitha," which means "she who bumps into things." Kateri's uncle took her in, and although she wanted to practice the religion of her mother, her uncle discouraged her. At the age of eighteen, Kateri began studying the Catholic religion in secret. After a time, her uncle gave his permission for her to become a Christian as long as she did not leave the village. There, she put up with ridicule because of her faith. In 1676, Kateri fled to Canada where she made her first Communion on Christmas, 1677. Although the last years of her life were difficult Kateri was known for her kindness and good humor. She died on April 17, 1680 and was canonized TODAY, OCTOBER 21, 2012 by Pope Benedict. (Judy Rozell and Lorry O'Connor and Sister Linda are there!)
