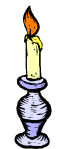

## Father Neil Draves Arpaia



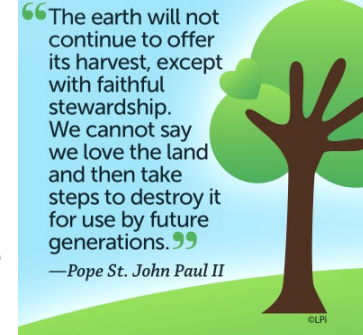
