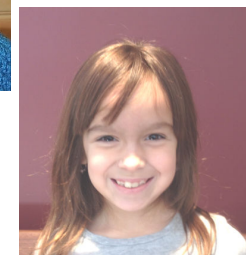


Would you like to help with Father Cox's 60th Anniversary Party?

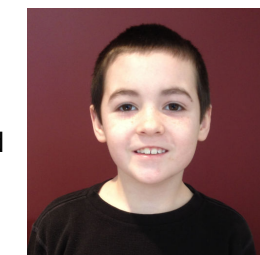
