 a few weeks. Is it helpful?.)

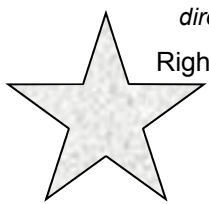
**Emergency Communion Service What if?**

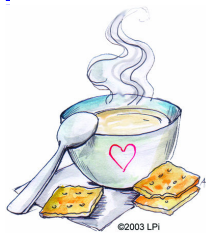
