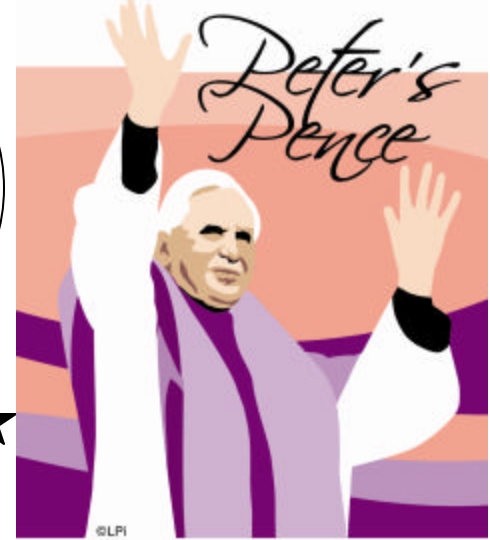

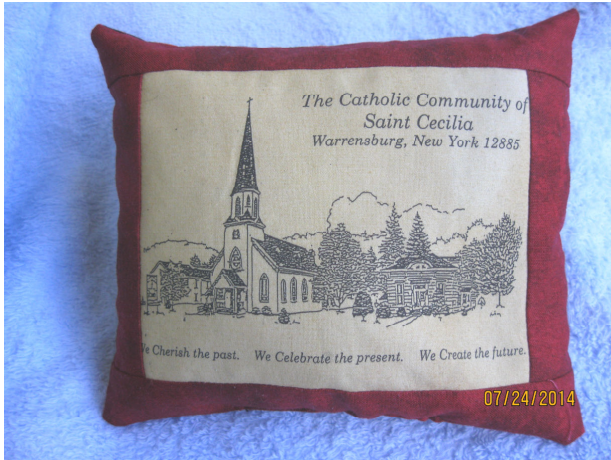
Sister Kitty is Associate Dean and Director of St. Bernard's School of Theology and Ministry in Albany. She served two terms in congregational leadership for the Sisters of St. Joseph and in that position, she made several trips to Peru and Chile. Sister Kitty also served as a contact person for Sisters preparing to serve in Peru.

Over 52 years, in response to Pope John XXIII's call to religious communities for help in Latin America, twenty Sisters of Saint Joseph were sent to Peru. Our beloved Sister Catherine Schuyler is among them, having served for 12 years. Throughout these years, young Peruvian women joined the Sisters of St. Joseph and now serve in schools, parishes, prisons, and in poverty-stricken neighborhood communities. Accompanying the people of Peru, especially families living in economic poverty, the CSJ's continue to live the mission of Jesus and, together with the People of God, strengthen the Church.
