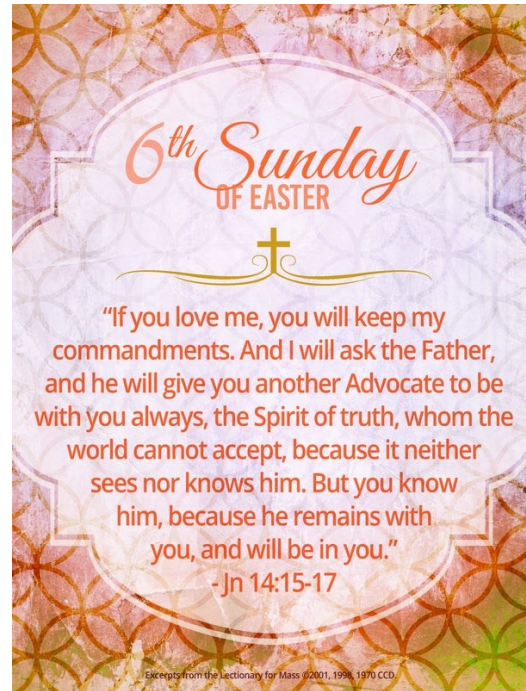

### RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

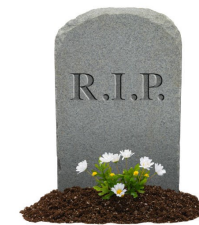

Envelopes have arrived. Please pick them up in the Narthex.

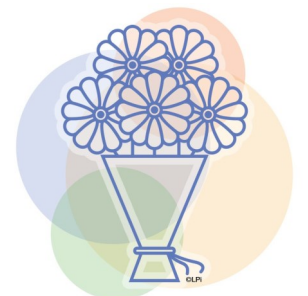
