RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS Should I Stay or Should I Go?

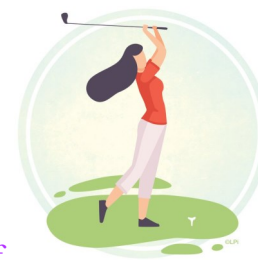
