

The Vineyard

The second son never showed up to the vine-  
yard. Did he get lost? Did he get tired? Did he not  
know where to begin?

When it comes right down to it, good inten-  
tions amount to very little. We all know this, don't  
we? "Show me, don't tell me." "I'll believe it when I  
see it." It's as true in the workplace and in relation-  
ships as it is in the life of the Christian disciple.

It doesn't matter if we *intend* to work in the  
vineyard. It doesn't matter if we promise to, if we  
think about it a lot, or if we make grand plans for  
what we will accomplish there. None of that matters  
if we don't show up. Before we show up, we have to  
find the way.

Showing up is the whole point. The work is  
the point, not the intention.

But all this begs the question: what does *the*  
*work* mean for us as baptized Catholics in the mod-  
ern world? Spending our Saturdays in soup kitchens  
and homeless shelters? Standing on a street corner  
shouting out the words of the Gospel?

Our baptismal call is to the vineyard. Where  
is our vineyard? How do we show up? *We are ready,*  
*Lord, we say. We intend to work. But where do we*  
*go?*

My vineyard is not your vineyard, and so it's  
not my place to tell you how to get there. I am glad  
you want to go, but you'll have to find your own  
way, just like I will. But I can tell you this: only one  
voice will lead you there. If you listen to it, you will  
find your vineyard.

## All Are Invited!


October is Our Lady of the Rosary
